

**INTERNATIONAL FOOD RESEARCH CONFERENCE (IFRC 2017)
POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

POSTER SPECIFICATIONS

- Poster should be **A1** size in portrait orientation.
- Place research title, author name(s) and the affiliation, in large letters centered at the top of the poster.
- Place the corresponding author's contact information (picture, address, phone number and email address) in the lower right-hand corner.
- Institutional logo(s) must be placed at the top of the poster.
- Use the headings **Abstract, Introduction, Methods/Methodology, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, and References** to identify your poster layout.

POSTER SET-UP AND POSTER EXHIBITION HOURS

- Posters should be placed on the assigned poster board during the following date and time:

- The detail on the each session will be provided on the Conference day.
- Tacks and push pins will be provided to all poster presenters.
- At least one author must be in attendance for presentation during poster judging session at the designated presentation date and time (kindly refer to the tentative programme).

POSTER REMOVAL

- Poster must be removed from the poster board after each session.
- Posters remaining on the boards after this time will be discarded.

TIPS FOR POSTER PREPARATION

- Text should be large enough to be seen from 4 feet (1.2192 meter) away.
- Poster should be organized in a way that leads viewers through the display.
- Poster should be easily understood.
- A neutral colored background is more pleasing to the eye than one on a bright colored background.
- Eliminate distracting visual noise.
- Poster should stimulate discussion; do not give text in complete/full sentences.
- Keep text to a minimum, emphasize graphics, and make sure everything in your poster is necessary; a viewer should "get it" in 30 seconds.
- You can utilize handouts to supplement your poster.
